Position Summary:

Reporting to the Vice President, HSE, the Manager, HSE Systems is responsible for supporting Capstone through the development, execution, and day-to-day management of the HSE systems, governance and data reporting activities. Key areas of focus include HSE performance analysis and response, content development and the execution of a decentralized HSE management model that provides governance and oversight of Capstone's operating assets.

Position Responsibilities (including but not limited to):

- Act as the Corporate HSE data and system owner.
- Collate and analyze HSE performance data and provide feedback that will drive consistency in reporting.
- Develop and prepare identified dashboards, information, reports and presentation materials for the HSE leadership forums, Site General Managers & HSE teams, Executive Committee (ExCo), annual organizational level report input and Board and Governance Committees reporting.
- Foster a HSE culture by ensuring data-driven key learnings and improvements are identified, shared and implemented across locations.
- Assist the Vice President, HSE in designing, writing and implementing an overarching HSE management system, processes and documents that will provide a decentralized governance and oversight model for an expanding mining organization.
- Any other projects/duties that may arise from time to time as required by the role and/or at the request of the Vice President, HSE.
